All entry fees refunded if withdrawn before closing date, after closing date only if filled. Will send ride times if SASE enclosed, otherwise times will be posted at www.blancadressage.com. Post entries accepted with \$10 fee. Class changes accepted where possible with no fee charged.

Refunds: Up to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled. During competition no refunds will be given. Office fee is non refundable.

Footing: Outdoor arena 20x60 soft dirt, watered. Warm up: soft dirt not watered.

Awards: Ribbons to 4th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties.
